- 3. The Community Council acquired the DJH from the Highland Council on 29 Sept., 2011 and the related Income/Expenditure are for a period of just over 6 months except the grants from HC were a non-recurring grant, £1750, and an annual grant, £1000, which is the maximum awarded for 12 months.
- 4. The at cost value of the DJH comprises £1 purchase price and £960 legal costs.

KILTEARN COMMUNITY COUNCIL - NOTES TO ANNUAL ACCOUNTS 2011/12 (continued)

- 5. The DJH Debtors £1572.70 represents hire charges due and the Creditors £447 represents £80 hire paid in advance, £1 owing for Hall purchase, £226 water charges and £140 electricity.
- 6. There are liabilities which may arise on the Project Fund of £22000 to Evanton Wood Community Company (£16000 purchase and £6000 activity programme) contingent on EWCC succeeding in funding the purchase of Evanton Wood and of £3000 to ARCH contingent on other funding. These awards have been agreed in principle.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- As explained in the notes, the Community Council agreed that any surplus in the General Fund would be transferred to the Project Fund as available which is the reason for the low balance on the General Fund at the end of the year. It was also agreed that the Secretary's and Treasurer's remuneration would be increased to the same level (£550) for 2011/12.
- 2. The balance on the **Project Fund** has increased over the years as a result of the low level of demand for Community Grants and, latterly, retention of funds for the anticipated demand for support from the Evanton Wood project.
- 3. The acquisition of the **Diamond Jubilee Hall** was expected to make further demands on the resources available. To date, however, there has been no additional demand from this and the DJH has been in surplus. There are plans to upgrade various features of the DJH and it is hoped that most of this will be met from grants.
- 4. The Kiltearn has, since 1998, benefited from the Community Benefit Fund which was negotiated with the developers of the original Novar Windfarm (Novar 1). The level of benefit is expected to be around £7600 in 2012/13 and is index linked.
- 5. The new development at Novar (Novar 2) undertaken by the current owners, RWE Npower Renewables is subject to a new Community Benefit agreement which is anticipated to provide a further £24300 pa to Kiltearn in 2012/13 also index linked.
- 6. There is a further RWE Npower Renewables (hydro) scheme on the River Glass expected to be completed in 2012/13 which is expected to result in a new source of funds for the community of £5000 pa.
